If you give up one of several residences in Germany you need to deregister the residence in question, unless you are at the same time registering another place of residence within Germany. You have to submit the deregistration form (filled out and signed) without delay at your Registration Office. If you have several addresses which are registered at different Registration Offices, any of those offices can process your deregistration.
